Passage- Hebrews 1:1-4

"In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, ² but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. ³ The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. ⁴ So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs."

- 1) When you think of God speaking to His people, *prior to Jesus' coming*, does a certain person (prophet, priest, or king from the Old Testament) or circumstance (from the Old Testament) come to mind? If so, then who or which one?
- 2) The purpose of the Book of Hebrews is:
 - (1) to Elevate the Person and Work of Jesus, and
 - (2) to challenge believers in Him to remain faithful no matter what.

Why is this important today?

Why is it important to know before beginning to read and study a book?

3) These first four verses, in Hebrews, reveal a lot about *the Person of Jesus Christ*. Name one that sticks out to you.
