Big Idea: We love God only because He first loved us

Matthew 22:34-40

³⁴ Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. ³⁵ One of them, an expert in the law, *tested him* with this question: ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?"

³⁷ Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

1 John 4:19 "We love because he first loved us."

- #5. Read the verse below. In the original language (Greek) "poured out" actually means a continual flooding. Knowing this, how can you reply more on the Holy Spirit to empower you love God, right now, in your life and current circumstances?
