## **Big Idea:** Generosity is a Heart Condition

## Study Questions-

- **#1.** When you think of generosity what comes to mind? When has someone been generous to you? When have you been generous to someone?
- **#2.** The Scripture is clear, in many places, that God is a generous God.

Example- "So Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide." - Genesis 22:14

Example- "For God so loved the world that He gave ..." – John 3:16

Can you think of other Scriptures about God being generous or examples of God being generous? (If you're stumped, how about in the life and ministry of Jesus?). Why is important for us to remember that God is generous?

- **#3.** The Big Idea of this message is *Generosity is a Heart Condition*. Do you agree or disagree with that statement. Why or why not?
- **#4.** In the sentence, "**practice hospitality**" (Romans 12:13), I was challenged to be hospitality, open, & receptive to God and to people. The two are directly connected. What are some practical ways we can remain open (hospitable) to God and to people?
